



RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF SELECTION OF DETROIT AS THE SITE OF THE 1968 OLYMPIC GAMES.

WHEREAS, the Algonac Village Council, of Algonac, Michigan; welcomed the decision of the United States Olympic Committee which honored the bid of the City of Detroit to represent the United States of America before the International Olympic Committee to invite the XIX Olympiad to that City; and

WHEREAS, the Algonac Village Council of Algonac, Michigan, endorses the selection of Detroit as America's representative; and

WHEREAS, the Algonac Village Council, of Algonac, Michigan feels that Michigan cities and villages should express their beliefs in the capacities and attractiveness of Detroit and SouthEastern Michigan which assures the successful accommodations of participants and guests, and should express their beliefs in the competance of Detroit to provide adequate facilities for the XIX Olympiad once the honor of selection is granted Detroit;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Algonac Village Council, of Algonac, Michigan, urge Michigan's cities and Villages through their legislative bodies to express their support of the efforts of the "Detroit Olympic Committee" in presenting all assets of this area to the United States Olympic Committee, so that they may favorably act to designate the City of Detroit, as the American representative before the International Olympic Committee; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the tangible expression of these sentiments be communicated to the Detroit Olympic Committee by means of a copy of a Resolution as a demonstration of the interest of Michigan's cities and villages, in the selection of Detroit as the site of the 1968 Olympic Games.
